Sharks Swim Team Parent Code of Conduct

As a proud member of the Sharks Swim Team community, we ask all parents to support a culture that is positive, respectful, and focused on the development and enjoyment of our youth athletes. We commit to the core values, expressed by the acronym F.L.I.P.P.E.R.S.:

F.L.I.P.P.E.R.S. – Our Core Principles

- F Fun Comes First: Swimming should be a joyful, rewarding experience. Every practice and meet should reflect the excitement of being in the water.
- L Learn the Sport: Parents are encouraged to understand the rules, structure, and flow of competitive swimming to support their child responsibly.
- I Inspire Positivity: Focus on lifting others up through words, actions, and energy. Encourage rather than criticize.
- P Positive Participation: Be a role model by engaging in ways that contribute to a healthy, upbeat team culture.
- P Play Your Role: Parents are supporters, not coaches or officials. Respect the boundaries of your role and allow coaches to coach.
- E Everyone Deserves Respect: Treat all swimmers, coaches, officials, and families with dignity—regardless of role, ability, or background.
- R Remain Substance-Free: Team spaces and events must be free from drugs, alcohol, and any substances that undermine safety and integrity.
- S Support the Team: Celebrate not only your child's achievements, but those of teammates. Build others up and help maintain a welcoming, dramafree environment.

Parent Expectations

As a parent/guardian of a Sharks swimmer, I agree to the following:

- 1. Prioritize enjoyment. I will ensure my child is having fun and that I contribute to a fun, engaging environment for all swimmers.
- 2. Let sport be for the youth. I will not use the swim team for my own personal gain, competition, or ego. I understand this experience is for my child, not for me.
- 3. Model good sportsmanship. I will lead with encouragement, support all swimmers, and refrain from negative comments toward any athlete, coach, or official.
- 4. Respect all team members and volunteers. Regardless of their role, background, or ability, every individual deserves respect.

- 5. Keep it clean. I will not possess or be under the influence of drugs or alcohol at any team-related events.
- 6. Let coaches coach. I will not attempt to coach or instruct my child or any other swimmer during practices or meets. I understand that this is the role of certified coaches and officials.
- 7. Be responsible for guests. I understand that any guest I bring to a practice, meet, or team function is expected to follow this Code of Conduct. I am responsible for ensuring they do so.

Creating a Positive Environment

- I will encourage effort, improvement, and teamwork over winning.
- I will help foster a welcoming and inclusive team spirit.
- I will avoid gossip, drama, or negativity that undermines the team's values.
- I will celebrate all swimmers' successes, big and small.

Disciplinary Actions

Failure to follow the Parent Code of Conduct may result in the following progressive actions:

- 1. Verbal Warning A coach or team official will address the behavior with you directly.
- 2. Written Warning & Parent Meeting A formal meeting will be scheduled, and a written document will outline the behavior and expectations moving forward.
- 3. Meet Forfeit You may be asked to leave a meet, and your child may forfeit participation for that event.
- 4. Parent Suspension You may be temporarily banned from attending team events or practices.
