Maine Appalachian Canoe Expedition

Maine Appalachian backpacking and canoeing expeditions explore the most remote stretches of the northern Appalachian Mountain Range, Flagstaff Lake and the Bigelow Preserve, the Rangeley Lakes, and/or the Moosehead region of Maine's Northwoods. This journey is an opportunity for those seeking a fresh challenge in a unique wilderness environment and an intense team/crew setting. As a team/crew member you will be expected to work collaboratively, listening, supporting, and respecting your fellow crew members to bring integrity to your team/crew. In the mountains, lakes and rivers, students learn to camp and travel simply, relying on each other and what they can carry on their backs.

On this 15-day course, **designed for students in grades 9-11**, you will explore the bold Appalachian Mountains and the picturesque rivers and lakes of Maine. You will depart the base camp on the first or second day of the course and not return until the end. You will carry what you need for as much as a week in your backpack and you will hike, paddle, or climb nearly every day.
